

TIMETABLE STRUCTURE

Though a personalised timetable will be provided for each student, please note the following:

Slot duration

Our timetable slots are two hours (e.g., 09:00-11:00) and consist of two lessons starting at each hour within that slot, lasting for 45 minutes (e.g., either 09:00-09:45 or 10:00-10:45).



Student assignment

Students will be assigned to one of these two slots to maintain smaller group sizes (e.g., **either** 09:00 **or** 10:00).



Multiple subject options

If there is more than one subject choice in a slot, students can be enrolled into both and will have two 45-minute lessons in that slot.
